### Course Sequence – Draft Overview

#### Year 1 (Foundational)

- Introduction to Music Instrument Repair 05149G0.5014F  
(basic tool use, safety, instrument anatomy, inspection, and routine maintenance)
- Instrument Maintenance & Diagnostics 05149G0.5024F  
(common repair issues, adjustment techniques, materials, and documentation)

Year 1 courses may be offered independently or concurrently, depending on staffing, facilities, and scheduling.

#### Year 2 (Specialization Options)

Schools select one or more options based on capacity and local needs.

- Woodwind & Brass Repair Fundamentals
- String Instrument Maintenance & Setup

##### Advanced / Applied Options

- Advanced Instrument Repair & Restoration (Strings, Percussion, Electronics)

- Courses may function as stand-alone electives or as a sequence.
- Advanced options may align with external training or apprenticeships, where available.
